Sermon Notes | John 15:1-11

Message discussion: What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

Passage reflection: Read John 15:1-11. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

Abide in Me, and I in you...

1. Read John 15:1-11. From these verses, what does it mean to abide, to draw life from Jesus? Can a person know Christ and not abide in Him?

As the branch cannot bear fruit by itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in me.

2. Jesus says that apart from Him we can't bear fruit. What is the "fruit" Jesus talks about in John 15? What if a person bears no fruit; what are the implications of that?

3. As Jesus talks about abiding in Him and bearing fruit, does it seem like He's describing striving or resting? What does spiritual fruit result from?

4. Are you abiding in Christ? Describe the spiritual fruit you see in your life. Describe what abiding in Christ day-by-day looks like for you.
