Sermon Notes | John 6:16-21

Message discussion: What stood out to you in this week's message? Questions? A way God moved you to respond?

Passage reflection: Read John 6:16-21. What stands out to you in these verses? Is there something you hear God saying to you? How can you respond to what He is saying?

Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. (Isaiah 41:10)

1. Read John 14:27. Jesus says that His peace is not given in the same way as the world's peace. Describe some differences between these two sources of peace.

"The peace of which He speaks is not dependent on circumstances, as any peace the world can give must necessarily be."

2. When things trouble your heart and you attempt to find peace by manipulating your circumstances, what does that look like?

3. Read the following verses: John 14:1-3; John 14:23-28. In these verses, Jesus describes realities that bring us His peace. Which one is most encouraging to you today? How can you cling to that this week?

4. Think about the peace which Jesus gives and where it is found. How can you cling to His peace this week instead of the world's as your heart is troubled?
